The meeting was opened up for discussion on what and how to proceed forward with the banners and brackets on Mineral and California Avenues. The committee had some discussions of what do we want and what we don't want to happen with these.

Opened the floor up to public comment. Sam Sikes brought up that the city does not have a bucket truck to help out on with hanging and changing them out. Sam also gave some of his idea's as to what he would like to see done with the banners. Promoting of the City of Libby, Welcome, area events displayed, and community being the soul for them.

Janelle Kimberlin then spoke about her thoughts and ideas for them as well as how to store them for seasonal conditions. Working with other community groups to help promote and take on some of the leg work as well was discussed. Chamber/City/Rotary/Etc.. There are a total of 45 brackets.
