

**UNAPPROVED
SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING
MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 28, 2015 @ 5:30PM
IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBERS @ CITY HALL**

The meeting was called to order at 5:30pm by Mayor Roll.

Mr. Olsen, Mr. Teske, Mr. Neff, Mrs. Williams, Mrs. Desch and Mrs. Raines were present.

The meeting was called to appoint a new judge for the City of Libby.

The candidates for City Judge are Lucille Briggs and John Klag.

John C. Klag residing at 274 N. Colorado Avenue, Libby spoke to the council about his Education, Training and Experience for why he should be appointed City Judge. There was a question and answer period.

Lucille Briggs was not present as she was attending the Fall Judge's Conference.

Allen Olsen made a motion to appoint John Klag for City Judge. Mr. Neff seconded the motion. There were several comments from the public and council. Mr. Olsen and Mr. Neff voted for motion. Mr. Teske, Mrs. Raines, Mrs. Desch and Mrs. Williams voted against the motion. Motion did not pass.

Mrs. Raines made a motion to appoint Lucille Briggs for City Judge. Mrs. Williams seconded the motion. Mrs. Williams, Mrs. Desch, Mrs. Raines and Mr. Teske voted for the motion. Mr. Olsen and Mr. Neff voted against the motion. Motion passed.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:12pm.
